Bartholomew Nathaniel, son of Talmai, lived in Cana of Galilee. His apostolic symbol is three parallel knives. Tradition says that he was a missionary in Armenia. A number of scholars believe that he was the only one of the twelve disciples who came from royal blood, or noble birth. Tradition also indicates that he was a great searcher of the Scripture and a scholar in the law and the prophets. He developed into a man of complete surrender of Jesus and one of the Church's most adventurous missionaries. It was also said that he preached in India and died as a martyr for his Lord. He was flayed alive with knives.
