Simon, the Zealot

Simon, the Zealot, one of the little known followers called the Canaanite or Zealots, lived in Galilee. In two places in the King James version he was called a Canaanite (Matt 10:4, Mark 3:18). However in the other two places he is called Simon Zealot. Simon was a fanatical Nationalist, a man devoted to the Law, a man with bitter hatred for anyone who dared to compromise with Rome. Yet Simon clearly emerged as a man of faith. He abandoned all his hatred for the faith that he showed toward his Master and the love that he was willing to share within the rest of the disciples and especially Matthew, the Roman tax collector. Tradition says that he died as a martyr. His apostolic symbol is a fish lying on a Bible, which indicates he was a former fisherman who became a fisher of men through preaching.
