TRAINING

Diabetic foot care course 2016

The annual Diabetic foot care course was organized by the Training Department on 15th and 16th January 2016. 8 participants from various parts of the country and from Sri Lanka benefited from the two day course. The sessions were conducted by faculty from Karigiri and from Tameside General Hospital, UK.

The training included lectures and demonstrations on various aspects of care of the Diabetic foot. The participants felt that the training was very useful for them since it had a lot of hands on practice. They felt that they could implement the practical aspects in their regular routine care of diabetic patients in their hospitals. The participants were also impressed with the care provided to all patients in Karigiri, especially those affected by Leprosy.

ORIENTATION FOR GOVERNMENT WORKERS IN LEPROSY

An orientation and training programme was held for government school health programme staff on 17th and 19th February 2016. On 17th, the staff of Vellore district participated from the training and on 19th, the staff of Tiruvannamalai district participated. The training session included sessions by the staff of dermatology, Orthopedics, Physiotherapy, and community health departments. About 50 people benefited from each of these training sessions.

OVERSEAS TRAINEES

Twenty five medical students and two Faculty members from Lund University, Sweden visited Karigiri on 18th Feb. 2016 who came to have exposure on leprosy. They were taught basics of medical and surgical aspects of leprosy with clinical demonstrations of cases. Students were very excited to see many cases and gave a good feedback about Karigiri.
